Finishes

Natural



The Natural finish is distinguished by a matte and non-reflective appearance that evokes the visual qualities of the materials that inspire the product. This sense of authenticity is enhanced by a soft and pleasant texture to the touch, which also contributes to its particular ease of cleaning. Thanks to these characteristics, it can be used in a wide variety of indoor spaces, from traditional settings to contemporary ones.

Natural Plus



The Natural Plus finish enhances the qualities of the Natural finish, offering a realistic appearance and a soft touch, with an R10 slip resistance rating. For this reason, it is ideal for interior design projects in spaces where higher slip resistance is required, such as bathrooms and other areas exposed to water and humidity.

Flamed



The Flamed finish replicates the characteristics of ancient bush-hammering techniques, resulting in a delicately textured surface that is soft to the touch. It adds character and harmony to installation projects in both indoor and outdoor spaces.

Structured



The Structured finish replicates the characteristics of an ancient stone processing technique that imparts a refined sense of longitudinal directionality to the material. The result is an artisanal-inspired interpretation that enhances spaces by combining naturalness and dynamism.

Antislip



The Antislip finish features a more structured texture, increasing friction and making it particularly resistant to slipping. Thanks to these qualities, it is ideal for outdoor applications, humid environments, and commercial or public spaces that require the highest safety standards.
